

The Greeley Ave. crossing located on the Long Island Rail Road's Montauk Branch in the Town of Islip requires emergency repairs and will require the closing of the railroad grade crossing to road traffic on Oct. 21st from Friday 11:00 pm to Monday Oct. 24 12:00am. As part of the emergency repairs the LIRR will install a new concrete grade crossing on the north track to replace the old defective rubber.

The following are detour routes:

South Bound:

Proceed south on Greeley Ave. to Easy Street, proceed west to Cherry Ave. and make left and proceed south to Brook Street and make left. Finally, proceed south on Greeley Ave.

North Bound:

Proceed north on Greeley Ave. to Brook Street make left, proceed west on Brook to Cherry Ave. make right and proceed North on Cherry Ave. proceed North on Cherry Ave to Easy Street. Finally, proceed east on Easy St. and make left on Greeley Ave. and proceed north.

Upon completion of the emergency repairs to the crossing temporary paving material will be placed between the Long Island Rail Road crossing panels and the saw cut line of the roadway.
